Fine Art Media: No Prep: Graphite, pen, ink, colored pencil, & marker. Clearprint should be primed for use with oils and acrylic. Paper should be taped to a ridged surface for use with watercolor and encaustics. Clearprint may be prepped with a workable fixative or a ground before use with pastel and charcoal. Dry media should be finished with a fixative.
